Dear Parents and Carers

Kent Road Public School aims to provide quality education for all students at our school. In order to assist our students to achieve educational outcomes it is imperative they have access to relevant resources and equipment. Your child's primary school education is forming the basis of their life's learning.

When one considers just a few of the expenses we pay for our children such as pre-school fees, sporting club fees, scouts, guides, dance groups, music lessons, etc, our fees are, for most families, very reasonable.

There are three components to the fees note attached.

1. An invoice for textbook fees and resources. All parents are asked to meet these costs which cover essential student items. It is important to note that in public schools, tuition is free but resources and activities have to be paid for by the consumer.

2. A request for a voluntary school contribution. This is requested each year by schools to supplement existing funding. Our school relies on these contributions to provide additional resources to ensure our students have the best possible learning opportunities and environment. We could not meet the high standards our community desires without additional funds made available by our parents.

In 2020 we are planning to purchase new playground equipment and replace the hall curtains. Our school is continually seeking ways to expand and enrich learning opportunities for all students.

3. A request for the P&C levy. This is a one-off payment for the year. These P&C funds will benefit each child. The P&C has undertaken to direct funds raised annually to purchase resources for the children as well as to pay for the buses for the end of year swimming program. Funds are not held in a bank account for the benefit of future generations. This ensures your financial support is benefitting your child.

The school has identified a number of priority areas for the school contribution funds in the provision of additional guided readers and home readers to accommodate our expanding school population, computer resources for classrooms, and subsidising the K-6 swimming program by paying for the buses.

All of these aspects of your child's education are very important. While we will continue to do our best to ensure that our children receive the highest quality in teaching obviously the task becomes more difficult when resources are stretched.

School contributions can be made in a number of ways. They can be paid in full or by instalments. They can be paid in cash or by cheque directly to the school office. They can be paid using a credit card either over the counter, by phone or by completing the slip attached to this letter.

I hope you will be able to assist us to continue to provide a quality education for your child.
