Principal's Report

SCHOOL INITIATIVES FOR 2019

Teachers have begun professional learning in three exciting new school initiatives which will benefit all students in our school.

i-Play: led by Miss Hossack, Miss Lyes and Miss Cramp

The i-Play program is an evidence-based professional learning program aimed at increasing student physical activity and fitness levels, and assisting teachers to develop their skills.

EALD EDUCATION PROJECT: led by Ms Kite, Mrs Gwynne, Miss Chan

This initiative will upskill all teachers with strategies to support students learning English.

MAKER PEDAGOGY NETWORK PROJECT: led by Miss Sheridan, Miss Brasier, Mr Higgins, Miss McKenna, Miss Houze, Miss Lanning and Miss Lindsay

This project provides professional learning for our teachers as well as resources to support the effective implementation of maker pedagogies to achieve STEM learning outcomes and improve students' critical, creative and design thinking abilities. The resources which the school will receive include three 3-D printers which will be a great addition to our STEM focus.

EXTRA CURRICULA ACTIVITIES (AFTER SCHOOL)

The activities and workshops the school has available before and after school in 2019 is listed on our school website along with contact details for the event provider. These activities fill-up fast so keep checking the website to see new activities as they are added.

I receive many requests from providers of after school programs and parents for activities to be offered at our school. Decisions about these programs are made by the school executive based on the educational value of the activity offered, the level of safety and supervision the provider can guarantee and the logistical considerations such as the space required.

The Writing Workshops which were advertised last week already have sufficient enrolments for the Year 1 and 2 group, and the Year 3 and 4 group, though there are still a few spaces available. I am hopeful to enlist few more students for the Years 5 and 6 group to make it viable.

Hopefully coming in Term Two is a new coding workshop. More details soon.

Kindergarten have had a great start to the year! The students have settled in well with their new routines and have made lots of new friends.








KL have been working hard in Literacy groups. Completing activities such as fine motor fishing, word work, initial sound games, reading, threading and learning to write their names.
