#### **BUILDING UPDATE**

I have been informed there will be work undertaken on Kent Road around the new electrical substation on Friday and possibly throughout next week, which will disrupt pedestrian traffic along the Kent Road footpath. The work will take place during school hours, that is, not as students are arriving or leaving school.

Traffic supervisors will be in place to ensure the safety of community members and Kent Road families.

#### SUPERVISION OF CHILDREN BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL

Should your child be waiting for a class, or a sibling to finish a class, they **must** remain under parents' supervision. That requires children to be in close proximity to their parents, carers or grandparents at all times.

Year Two have been working very hard so far and we have started to get creative with our artworks! Our classrooms are now starting to fill up with some fantastic, colourful pieces of art.



# Would you like to be a Kent Road Class Parent during 2020?

.Kent Road Class Parents play a vital role in acting as a communication link between our school, our teachers, our Parents and Citizens (P&C) Association and the parents/carers in each class. Much of the Class Parent role is completed using email as a form of communication to relay important information from the school, the class teachers, and/or P&C, and it is therefore essential that our Class Parents access and use email regularly as part of their role.

The key responsibilities of a Class Parent include:

- Collect voluntary contact information (name and email address, phone number optional) from parents/carers in your class to:
- o Generate an email distribution list
- Put together a class directory
- Liaise with the class teacher about class needs
- Relay important information from the school or your class teacher via the email distribution list, including but not limited to:
- o Information or reminders about upcoming school events
- Call for volunteers at various school events throughout the year (e.g. cake stall at Athletics Carnival)




