YEAR TWO ASSEMBLY

The Year Two assembly scheduled for this Friday 13th March has been postponed due to concern regarding the coronavirus. I am hoping to have clarification on this matter and the assembly will be rescheduled as soon as possible.

CORONAVIRUS

The latest update from the NSW Department of Education and NSW Health, issued on Monday 9th March, is available on our school website.

The update states:

- 1. No child should attend school if they are sick. Children should remain at home until symptoms resolve.
- 2. Any student or staff member who has returned from China since 1st February, Iran since 1st March or South Korea since 5th March is excluded from school, childcare or work for 14 days.

Parents and/or children who are unwell with flu-like symptoms should phone their doctor or a medical centre to inform them you are unwell and to inquire about procedures for medical assessment.

I have received a large number of emails from parents with suggestions regarding the management of coronavirus. I would like to assure parents that since the beginning of Term One the school has implemented all infection control measures as directed by the NSW Department of Education.

These include:

- For Teaching students how and when to wash their hands and the importance of using soap;
- Sneezing or coughing into their elbow or covering their mouths with a tissue;
- Reminding students, whenever possible, to not touch their faces.

It is important that all parents discuss these hygiene practices with their child at home to further reinforce what the teachers are saying at school.

Further information will be passed on to parents as it is received by the school.

The survey measures factors that are known to affect academic achievement and other student outcomes. The focus of the NSW-wide survey is on student wellbeing, engagement and effective teaching practices.

I want to assure you that the survey is confidential. The survey is conducted online and will typically take less than 30 minutes to complete. It will be administered during school hours between 9 March and 8 May. Participating in the survey is entirely voluntary.




The consent form and FAQs are available in 23 languages.

Year 3 love Science Experiments

Year 3 have been busy studying life on the Great Barrier Reef. This lesson was about conducting a pollution experiment to find out how oil can affect animals on the Great Barrier Reef. We mixed oil and water together then added placed plastic toys. We tried to clean the toys with just a sponge but that did not work, so we had to use detergent to clean the toy properly. This experiment helped the students understand how hard it is to get oil off animals in the Great Barrier Reef and the importance of making sure oil does not go down the sink.




















Shop Opening Times - The Kent Road Uniform Shop is **open every Monday of school term from 8.45 until 9.30am.**
