### **RAPID ANTIGEN TESTS**

We continue to record positive covid cases each day across all grades. Thank you parents for continuing to keep your children at home when they are sick or are household contacts.

Today students have been provided a set of rapid antigen tests which have been issued by the NSW government. Parents should be aware some students have been issued saliva tests, others have the nasal tests. PLEASE READ THE LABEL ON THE BOX.

### CHANGES TO ISOLATION REQUIREMENTS

The NSW government announced changes to the Public Health Orders this week.

• People who test positive to COVID-19 and complete their 7-day self-isolation period **do not have to test or self-isolate** for **12 weeks after their release**.

Self-isolation means staying at home or at your accommodation. This means you cannot drive your children to school or day care; you must ask someone else to do this. You must only leave self-isolation to get medical care or in an emergency.

### KINDERGARTEN, YEAR ONE AND YEAR TWO HAT PARADE

Parents of students in Kindergarten, Year One and Year Two are invited to attend the K-2 Hat Parade on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> April at 9.30am. (Please be aware that parent attendance will be weather dependent. We will advise parents if the organisation needs to be changed.)

### SCHOOL PHOTOGRAPHS

The School Photographer will visit the school on 6<sup>th</sup> April to take individual, class and sibling photographs. Students are asked to wear full school uniform including green socks and black shoes.

### SCHOOL FEES
