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Year 4 News

This term in the Science unit, 'Food and Fibre', Year 4 students have been exploring farming processes and technology (as seen in last week's newsletter).

To begin with, students investigated some natural food and fibre products and the journey they take to become a product we can buy in the shops.

Students have also worked in groups to design and make a model of an irrigation system.

Currently, students are working collaboratively to design and create a prototype of a new sustainable technology that will improve farming for the future. Some classes have had the opportunity to present their models to their buddies this week.

It has been a highly engaging unit, enjoyed by both students and teachers.












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ROZ the Robot has a button in the middle of his body that the farmer presses to detect the soil health.

This incredible robot checks if the soil is ready to have seeds planted in it.

When the seeds grow, ROZ assesses whether the plants need sunlight or water.
Depending on the results, ROZ addresses the plants needs with an inbuilt light that replicates the sun or an inbuilt watering system if the plant is dehydrated.

ROZ is powered through solar panels that are on his back.

Parents and their child will meet teachers, learn about our programs and visit classrooms. Entry will be via Kent Road.


